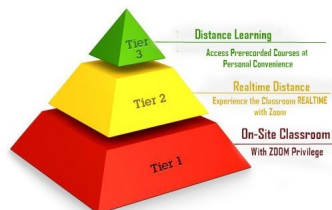
Plans for the New School Year

The 2019-2020 school year was a year in which everyone at CBI expanded their knowledge.

The Corona Pandemic caused us to close our doors for the last 3 months of the school year and forced us to rely on ingenuity and initiative to provide the best educational environment we possibly could with the circumstances we were handed.

We fully intend to return to the classroom in August, but in light of our recent experience with the Corona virus we are now in the process of preparing both our facilities and our faculty to enter the world of E-learning on a much larger scale.

We will be implementing three



distinct tiers of instructional opportunities for our students.

Tier 1: On-Site

This tier of instruction is our normal onsite classroom instruction, but we will also be incorporating ZOOM usage in the classroom for those students who need this access in times of necessary absences.

Tier 2: Realtime Distance

This tier of instruction will permit the student to electronically be a part of the classroom during the actual time when the instructor and the onsite students are meeting by using Zoom as well.

This provides the opportunity for students enrolled in this tier, who are unable to travel to our facilities to be a part of the classroom activities real-time.

Tier 3: Distance Learning

This tier will be actual prerecorded video classes



which the student will be granted access to view at their convenience.

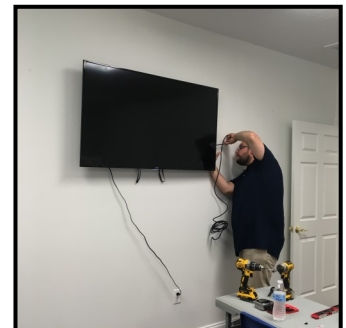
While the learning process has been trying and uncomfortable it has proven beneficial as I am confident that God has opened doors for us to reach students both across the street as well as around the world.
